Winemaking

In a Central Coast winery's pursuit of a Burgundian expression of Pinot Noir, we seek out vineyard sites with sandy soils. Small amounts of whole cluster are essential to providing savory nuances in the wine. We are deliberate in how gentle we are during fermentation to retain integrity of the fruit. 100% of this wine is aged in French oak with 6% of that being new.

The Silkworm and the Spider

A silkworm worked slowly and diligently on her shroud, while a spider hastily spun a web. The spider was arrogant about her quantity of work, and bragged to the silkworm. But the silkworm continued her methodical approach; she knew she was building something that would last.

This fable is about quality vs. quantity. We still want to bring the small-side winemaking that we know to this project. We want to take care and build something that will grow, instead of doing everything the quickest way. It might take more time or money, but it meets our standard of detail, even while it scales. Even in our winemaking, all of our red wines are barrel-aged; there's no tank storage.

Tasting Notes

Bold, fresh cranberries and raspberries float on your palate, brought back to earth by gentle nutmeg, clove and just a hint of mushroom. Brings you back to days spent basking in the Central Coast sunlight.
